What we know:

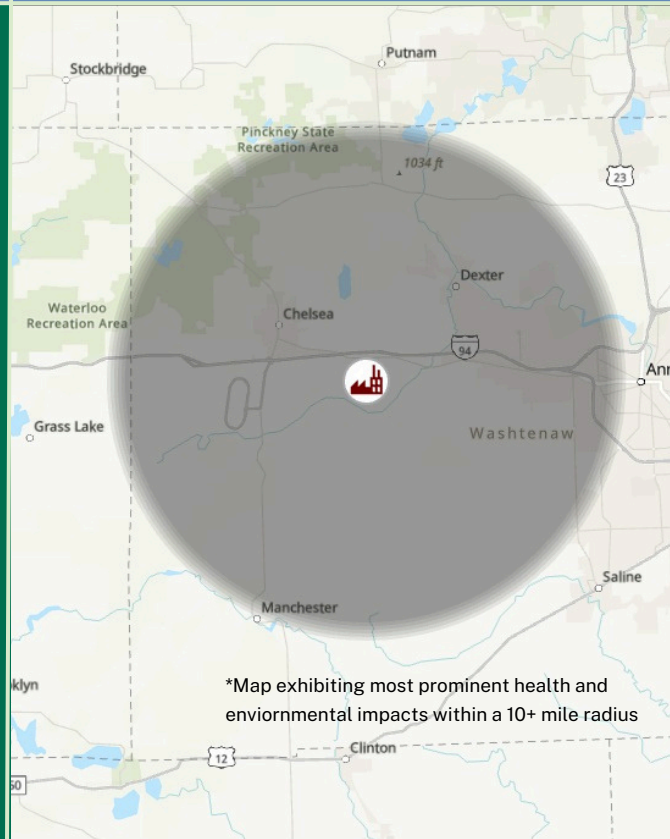
- 1,414 Megawatt Natural Gas Power Plant
- Consumers Energy has optioned 120-acres of agricultural land in the center of Lima Township, approximately 10-miles west of Ann Arbor, Michigan.
- The moratorium that has paused the power plant discussion expires in August 2027

How does this impact our community?

- Threat to rural and agricultural landscape
- Impacts local wildlife and natural habitats
- Effects on local resident health
- Economic impact on property values, food production, and small businesses

Other impacts beyond Lima Twp

- Air pollution and noxious emissions that can reach up to hundreds of miles downwind (EPA, 2026)
- Noise and light pollution
- Potential groundwater contamination - impacting future health of Mill Creek and Huron River Watershed.



The impacts of power plant emissions are not limited to the area immediately adjacent to a plant. Because air pollution can travel over long distances, the impacts of power plant emissions can be felt locally as well as many miles away, meaning that the air quality in a community can be impacted by far-distant sources as well as those sited near a community. (EPA, 2026)

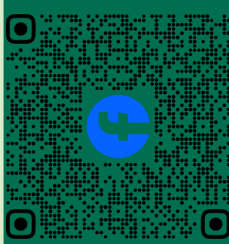
